

ALOUETTE

Lolium multiflorum

- Persistency on the border to hybrid ryegrass group
- Very good rust resistance
- High tolerance to Xanthomonas
- Suited for conservation or mixed use

Biannual

There are no clear frontiers between annual ryegrass (*Lolium perenne*) and biannual ryegrass (*Lolium multiflorum*). ALOUETTE is particular being a rather persistent biannual type showing better persistency after both 1st and 2nd year of exploitation. This allows maximum return on investment and can be an alternative to choosing a "pronounced Italian type hybrid ryegrass".

Quality Insurance

ALOUETTE is not a quality compromise: Fewer stems in aftermath, high resistance to rusts and excellent Xanthomonas tolerance. Yield distribution is better than in dedicated conservation types and mixed use cut/grazing is possible.

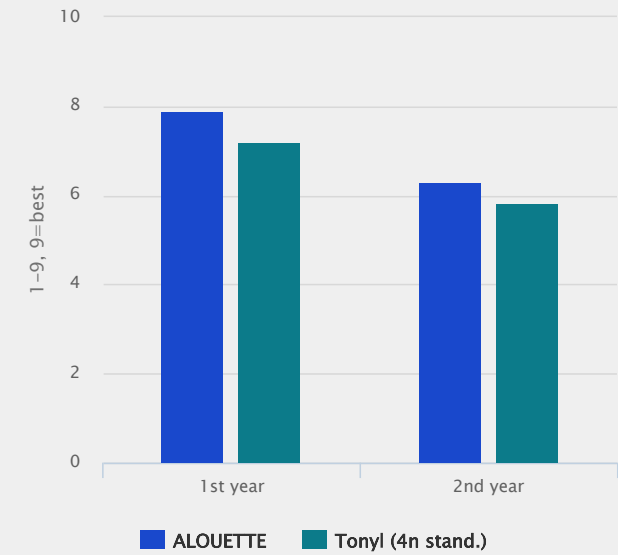
