Resilience and anchoring through lateral spread

You obtain a weed competitive turf, fit for traffic and wear challenged areas, with lower need of maintenance resulting in lower costs and less time spent on maintenance. Even when establishment is under sub-optimal conditions with a lower plant density, the ability of CREEPSTAR to fill in the area through more tillers and prostrate growth habit, allows a better compensation.

Fineleaved, dense and disease tolerant

With a high shoot density and superior fineness of leaves, the visual merit is excellent throughout the year. Exhibits good tolerance to frequent diseases like red thread and rust.

Uses

CREEPSTAR is an excellent choice for both recreational areas (homelawns, public parks..), playgrounds and extensive sport fields where the lateral spread will add a lot of resilience to maintain the ground covered and avoid bare spots/weeds.

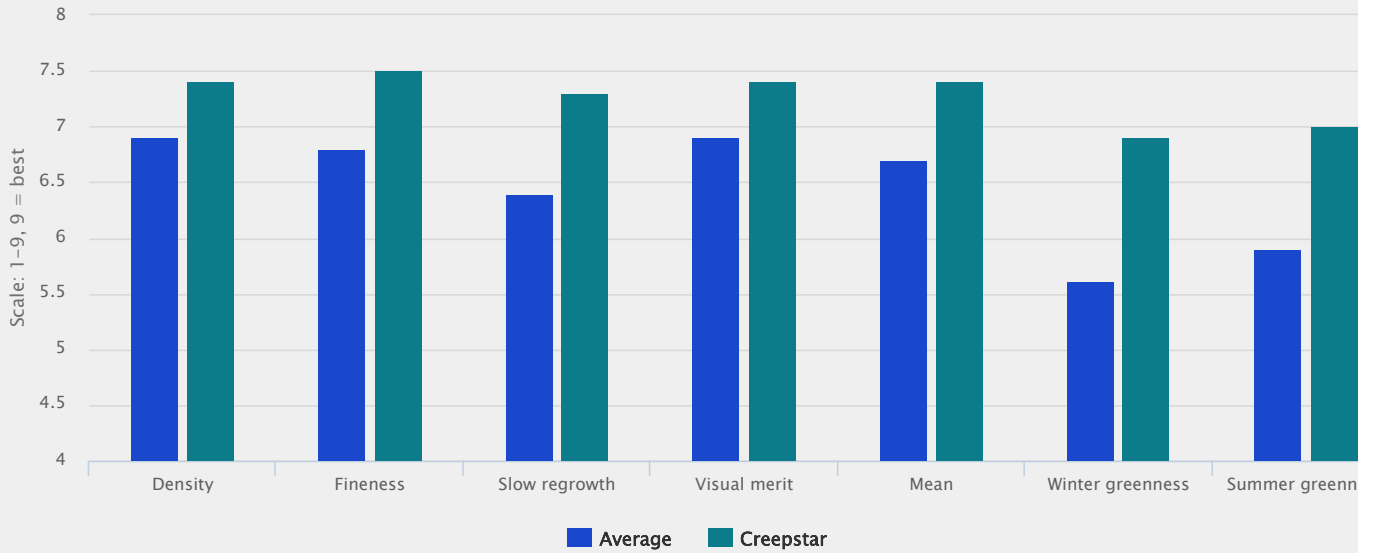
