Characteristics

JEANNE develops very few stems in the year of sowing, which makes it differ significantly from Westerwoldicum. Nevertheless, JEANNE has a very good resistance to lodging.

Resistance to Diseases

With the character 2.5 in the official trials in France for rust, JEANNE is the very top variety within this category.

Fantastic Yield as Intercropping

In Italy Jeanne was tested and giving the impressive result of rel. 114 in drymatter compared to all listed varieties.
