Early growth and big 1st cut

MONDORA exploits the first signs of the coming spring to initiate early leaf growth and develop a very big first cut. Mondora yields well in the following cuts too

Easy to establish

Sowing can take place in spring or from late summer into the autumn. The vigorous seedlings rapidly contribute to full groundcover.

True Italian ryegrass

MONDORA is of the *Lolium multiflorum* type, ensuring higher persistence than Annual ryegrass.
