Festuca arundinacea

- Bred for airfields

## Breeding aimed at airfields for increased security and cost savings

NEBULA was selected for improved adaptation to airfields in mind. This means stiff hard stems and foliage. But also low digestibility to produce as little "feed" as possible while preserving the long term cover of the airfields.

## Low maintenance

NEBULA is growing just enough to maintain the cover and thrives well with the cutting heights applied in airfields. NEBULA also accepts the rather low fertiliser levels common for airfields.

The features of NEBULA also makes it a good choice for other areas, like golf courses, e.g. as a component of rough mixtures.
