

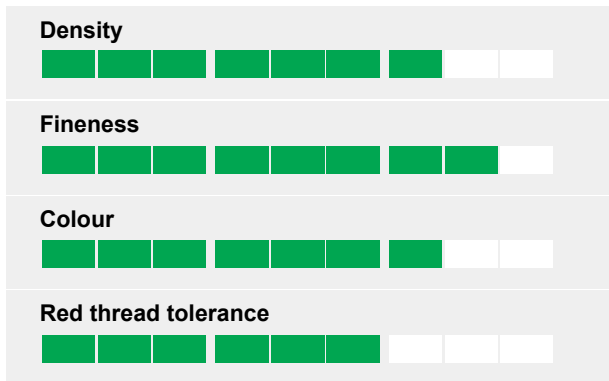


Strong creeping red fescue

Dark green with improved winter visual merit and better Fusarium tolerance

- Improved tolerance to Fusarium
- Better visual merit during winter months
- Darkest green strong creeping red fescue

The best rating for Fusarium tolerance

In the German BSA list RUDDY expresses the highest score for Fusarium tolerance. Very convenient to reduce damage and aim at reduced or no use of fungicides.

Improved appearance during winter

RUDDY keeps the winter colour and visual merit better than all other varieties on the BSA list for Lawn varieties. This adds to the value for both ornamental lawns/parks and use on e.g. golf fairways.

Darker green colour

RUDDY is one of the darkest green strong creeping red fescues available on the market.
